Heraeus Precious Metals GmbH & Co KG, a leading international gold refiner and bar manufacturer, modified the company's official stamp and the format of some words on its range of small cast and minted bars in May 2011.

Cast: 1000 g, 500 g, 250 g, 100 g
Minted: 100 g, 50 g, 20 g, 10 g, 5 g, 1 g, 1 oz
Kinebar®: 20 g, 10 g, 5 g, 2 g, 1 g, 1 oz

In addition, the company started recording serial numbers on minted bars for the first time, as well as presenting minted bars in attractive new packaging that includes an assay certificate.

The main change to the world-renowned "hand-with-roses" official stamp is the removal of the letters, "GMBH".

The modified official stamp and revised format are also being applied to Heraeus gold bars that are manufactured by the company's subsidiaries, **Heraeus Limited** (Hong Kong) and **Heraeus Incorporated** (USA), and by its affiliated company, **Argor-Heraeus SA** (Switzerland).

Heraeus Holding GmbH, through **Heraeus Precious Metals GmbH & Co KG**, is the world's largest privately owned precious metals refiner and fabricator.

The company, which traces its formal origins back to 1851, has its international headquarters in Hanau, about 25 km east of Frankfurt.
